3. Application Requirements

- High school graduates, college students or graduates (out of school for less than 2 years).
- Determined to study in Japan, studious, honest and healthy.
- Economically feasible applicants.

4. Selection System

- The applicants must pass the written examination and interview; Excellent students will be preferred by strict selection principle.
- The foreign intermediary companies or agents firstly should fax us the applicant's Application Form (made by our college); Written examination and interview will be arranged after the documents scrutiny.
- The interviewees have to bring the completed Application Form, final graduating school certificate original and original ID; high school graduates who have taken the National Entrance Examination have to bring the Admission Card original and examination score transcript, etc.

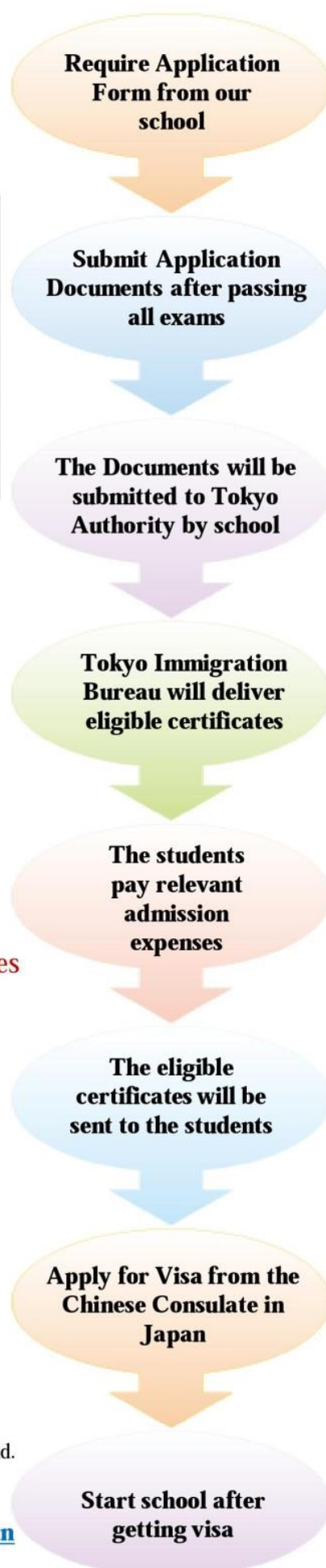

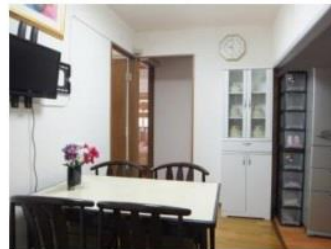

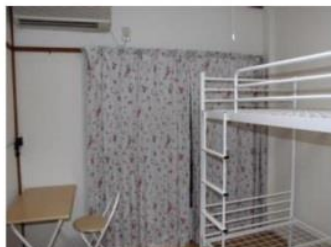
